especially high spring tide King tides occur a few times every year, when the gravitational pull of the sun and moon upon the earth is strongest This happens when the moon is closest to the earth in its monthly orbit When this coincides with a spring tide, it will produce an especially high tide, or king tide

During high tide, ocean levels are higher on shorelines During low tide, ocean levels are lower on shorelines Spring Tide vs Neap Tide Spring Tides-• Though the sun is much farther from Earth than the moon, its huge mass exerts a pull of gravity that also affects Earth's ocean tides
